Books about Bullies for Kids

These books can be used as a conversation starter for how to deal with bullies

The Berenstain Bears and the bully by Stan and Jan Berenstain (E Ber)

When she takes a beating from the class bully, Sister Bear learns a valuable lesson in self-defense--and forgiveness.

Bluebird by Bob Staake (E Sta)

An exploration of the universal themes of loneliness, bullying, and friendship traces the poignant journey of a bluebird who makes the acquaintance of a young boy and ultimately risks his life to save the boy from harm.

Bullies are a pain in the brain by Trevor Romain (j302.3 Rom)

A serious yet humorous guide to dealing with bullies.

Bully by Patricia Polacco (jF Pol)

Sixth-grade friends Lyla and Jamie, both new to their school, stand up for each other when a clique of popular girls bullies them online.

Bullying and me: schoolyard stories by Ouisie Shapiro (j302.3 Sha)

Children from all kinds of neighborhoods and schools talk openly about their experiences of being bullied.

Llama Llama and the bully goat by Anna Dewdney (E Dew)

Following their teacher's lead, Llama Llama speaks to Gilroy Goat and tells him he should not act like a bully on the playground.

The Odd Squad: Bully Bait by Michael Fry (jF Fry)

When his school counselor insists that he needs better socialization skills after being stuffed into a locker by a bully, middle-schooler Nick finds himself, along with two other misfits, joining the school's lamest club: Safety Patrol.

Odd, weird & little by Patrick Jennings (jF Jen)

Befriending a very strange new student, Toulouse, helps outsider Woodrow stand up to the class bullies who have been picking on them both.
