Library Services During COVID

- Open to the public since July 2020, six days per week (48 hours)
- Contactless pickup option six days a week for patrons who prefer not to come into the building
- Virtual programming for all ages, including NEA Big Read, COVID programming with JAX and the hospital, and virtual storytimes
- Expanded digital services Launched Hoopla digital service ebooks, e-audiobooks, movies, TV, and music
- Joined the statewide Minerva consortium of 6o+ libraries, providing easy access to 8 million items
- "Library on the Lawn" and outdoor storytimes this summer

FY22 Budget Request

- Total Budget: \$672,207 (flat)
- Other Revenue: \$126,300 (increase of \$15,800)
- City Appropriation: \$544,907 3% less than last year and 81% of the total budget, the lowest it's ever been

FY22 Revenue

- Non-Resident Card Fees: \$7,500
- Miscellaneous Revenue: \$12,000
- Fundraising: \$15,000
- Investment Fund: \$41,800
- Town Funding: \$50,000
- City Appropriation: \$544,907

Historical Decrease in City Appropriation: FY04 – FY22




Percentage of total library budget that is city funding


Strategic Plan Goal: Funding Diversification The library's 2018-2021 strategic plan included goals to reduce the city's appropriation and increase annual appeal giving by 15%.

- The city appropriation has steadily declined since FY19 (dollar amount) and the percentage has declined since FY17.
- Annual appeal giving increased 18% in 2020.
